

Infant Curriculum Newsletter Spring Term 2018

This term our topic will be space and Journey to the Moon.

Please help by supporting your child with their learning at home.

We would like each child to spend at least ten minutes a day carrying out a reading activity. This can consist of reading together or your child reading a book to you. This daily activity does not always have to involve looking at your child's reading scheme book and we would actively encourage you to use a range of different materials including picture books and poems.

Your child's reading books need to be brought into school every day and they will be changed at least twice a week. Re-reading a book encourages fluency. The children will also have the chance to choose library books to take home and share. We ask that you write in their reading record to indicate that you have heard your child read and when appropriate to write a brief comment about their reading.

The children will also have a phonics book to take home, indicating the sounds they are currently working on in school. Practising them at home as well really makes a difference to their progress. At the front of the book you will also find a handwriting sheet to show the correct formation of the letters and the rhymes we use to help remember them.
