Health and Safety Inhalers We have revisited our procedures regarding the use of inhalers and would request that all children carry their own inhaler (in the infant class, the class teacher will help the child to look after the inhaler), and also that parents provide a spare for school. The spares will be kept in the office in a bag for each child and will be collected when children are taken out on trips whether or not

the child has their own inhaler. There will also be a spare inhaler in school. All parents will need to sign a form to say that they are happy for their child to use the spare inhaler.

PE Kit, Sun Hats and Water Bottles Please ensure your child has a sun hat, PE kit and a water bottle in school during the summer term. This is so they are prepared to work outdoors, can have a drink when required and to minimise spread of any infections.

Note: Please ensure your child has the summer PE kit. This is a white t-shirt/polo top, black/blue shorts and trainers or plimsolls.

Sun Cream Please ensure that children are sent to school with the protection they require. Sun cream should be applied in the morning before they arrive at school.
